

# 2 Days Experience in Ethiopia

## Day 1: Addis Ababa City Tour

- **Morning:** Start your day with a visit to the National Museum of Ethiopia, located in Addis Ababa. Here you can see the famous fossil remains of "Lucy," a 3.2-million-year-old ancestor of humans.
